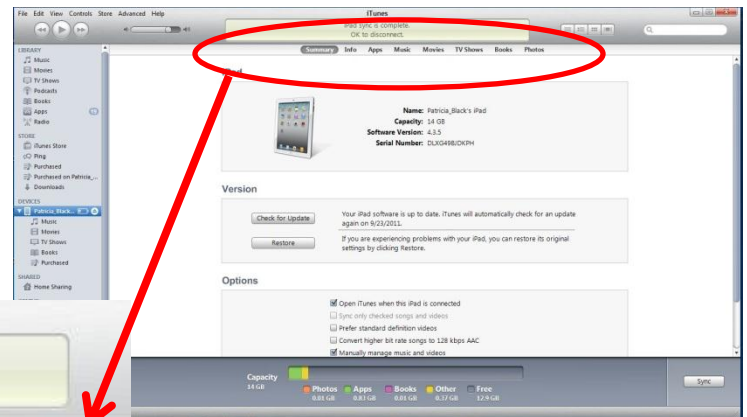


Transferring Photos to your iPad

1. Connect your iPad to your computer using the USB cord that came with your iPad.
2. Please wait for iTunes to sync and backup your iPad. You will know it is done because your iPad will be listed on the left sidebar.



3. Click once on your device name to select it. The screen on the right hand side will change to look like this (picture on right).
4. On the top part of this screen look for this menu bar and select Photos (picture below).



5. Check the box next to Sync Photos from. Now you will want to select the folder you would like to sync. You can sync ALL your photos from My Photos or select a specific folder. Our suggestion would be to create a folder on your computer that will house the photos you want on your iPad. In this example I have created a folder named 'Photos for iPad'. On my computer as I download a picture and want to put it on my iPad I just make a copy and save it to this 'Photos for iPad' folder. The next time I sync the iPad my photos will sync. To set this up, I chose the folder photos for iPad from the drop down menu. If you will be putting any videos you will want to put a check in the Include videos option. Now to make this happen you will click on Apply (lower right hand corner of this screen). It will then perform the initial sync. From now on it will do this automatically when the iPad is connected to iTunes.
