Course Projects (BSPH/MPH)

We are always looking for community-based partners for course projects. We develop and/or deliver health promotion programs and events, community health assessments, grant proposals, and program evaluations.



Group Events

Do you have a major assessment or health promotion event happening over a weekend? Picture the possibility of a group of our Baylor MPH/BSPH students traveling to your location to help! Let's talk about possibilities.



Volunteers

Students *may* be available (depending on their school/work schedules) to volunteer individually for a single event or on a regular basis.



Summer Practicum (MPH only)

MPH Students work with an organization on a specific project in their 200-hour summer practicum. Examples: program development, evaluation, assessment, research, grant-writing.



Internship

MPH students may complete a 400-hour internship as their final graduate project (spring semester). BSPH students complete a 320-hour internship (semester varies). Their work is tailored to organizational public health needs.



Thesis (MPH only)

MPH students can opt to complete a research thesis as their final graduate project. Allow a thesis student to use research methods to gather information about your service area/program needs and validate intervention outcomes.
