- Professional Writing and Rhetoric majors should check the bulletin published by the English Department each semester during registration for descriptions of courses offered the following semester.
- Professional Writing requirement: In addition to ENG 3318, 4309 and 4377, Professional Writing and Rhetoric majors must complete two courses from the following: 3313, 3316, 3317, 3326, or 4375.
- Workshop or project-based courses: majors must choose 9 hours from the following: ENG 3300, 3303, 3309, 3385, 4311, 4321, 4323, or 4348.
- Elective English courses: Majors choose one additional 3000-4000 level literature course. Also, majors choose 1 additional 3000-4000 level course from literature, creative writing, or linguistics (non-PWR course).
- A grade of "C" or better is required for all courses for the major. At least 9 hours of 4000-level courses required in the department.
