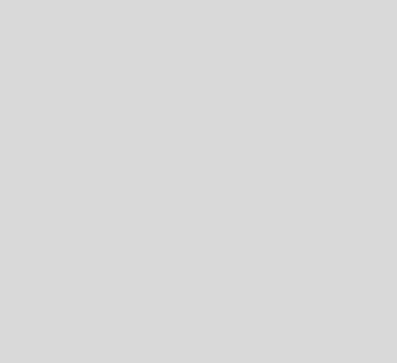
Register for Civic Life Summit
