- *Students completing World Cultures I, II, III and IV in the Baylor Interdisciplinary Core may petition for credit for GTX 2301 and 2302. Note: Cultures I-IV cannot be applied to any other major/minor option.
- This pre-med plan assumes that a student will be taking the MCAT at the end of junior year. Should a student need to complete MTH 1320 as pre-requisite to MTH 1321, modifications would need to be made.
