- Core Pre-Law Course options: At least 3 courses from PSC 3302, 3321, 3339, 4305, 4307, 4342, 4361, and 4381.
- Pre-law preparation: law schools generally encourage pre-law students to achieve a broad cultural background, and many students enter law school with an undergraduate major in political science.
- PSC subfields: Students need one introductory course from each of the four subfields: PSC 1305; PSC 2343; PSC 3304; and PSC 3315.
- Check your degree audit often through Bearweb to ensure that you are making timely progress toward your degree.
