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Profile of Graduate School Students Fall 2018 and Fall 2019

This report contains descriptive information for students enrolled in programs in the Graduate School in Fall 2018 and Fall 2019. If a student is in two different programs (BBA/MBA, MBA/MSIS, JD/MTax, MDiv/MM, etc.), the student is counted in <u>each</u> program in the appropriate academic unit (i.e., program count).

Citizenship Status

Fall 2019

The program count of 3,096 includes three students classified as Graduate Non-Degree. There are 995 new graduate students. Forty-three percent of the graduate enrollment are males, and thirty-four percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Eighteen percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

Ninety-one percent of these students are United States citizens, while 293 (9.5%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 56 foreign countries. The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) Verbal percentile range for the middle fifty percent of graduate students is 52 - 86 with a mean of 67. For the Quantitative portion of the GRE, this range is 38 - 71 with a mean of 54.

Fall 2018

The program count of 2,403 includes four students classified as Graduate Non-Degree. There are 647 new graduate students. Fifty-one percent of the graduate enrollment are males, and twenty-nine percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Twenty percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

Ninety percent of these students are United States citizens, while 244 (10%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 49 foreign countries. The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) Verbal percentile range for the middle fifty percent of graduate students is 55 - 89 with a mean of 70. For the Quantitative portion of the GRE, this range is 40 - 74 with a mean of 57.
