7) Supplemental Recruitment Initiatives.

(a) Initiative: **Job Fairs**

KWBU participated in 3 job fairs during this reporting period. The first was the Texas Association of Broadcasters (TAB) Career Expo at Baylor University on March 28, 2007 It was sponsored by the TAB in cooperation with Baylor University's Department of Communication Studies. KWBU was represented by Joani Livingston, Production Supervisor and Jessica Denk, Senior Producer.

The second event was the Killeen Daily Herald Jobfair, also on March 28, 2007 at the Killeen Civic and Conference Center. KWBU was represented by Glenda Moss, KWBU Business Manager at the Killeen event.

The third event was the Heart of Texas Workforce Youth Career Expo held on June 29, 2007 on the Texas State Technical College Waco campus. The HOT Workforce serves the six-county Heart of Texas region, including Bosque, Falls, Freestone, Hill, Limestone and McLennan Counties. KWBU was represented by Glenda Moss, KWBU Business Manager at this event.

At each event KWBU employees visited with numerous prospective employees and explained the types of positions typically available at KWBU-TV and KWBU-FM.

(b) Initiative: TV Work-Study Program with Baylor University

The station sponsors Baylor University work-study students who are paid for working up to 20 hours per week in various KWBU departments. Students Molli Leggitt worked for KWBU-TV's production of "Inside Baylor Sports" from 1/28/07 - 12/20/07 where she got "hands on" experience in sports production and editing under the supervision of Senior Producer Robert Shiekh. Ashlea Mangum took over this same position with Inside Baylor Sports on 1/27/08 – also under the supervision of Robert Shiekh.

(c) Initiative: Internship program with Baylor University

KWBU TV & FM has worked with Baylor University professors as well as posting announcements on the Baylor Information Network to make students aware of the opportunities available for internships.

KWBU-TV has interns working with TV Station Manager Clare Paul during the past year. These students typically worked approximately 10 hours per week and assisted with editing program guide listings, writing press releases and preparation for mailings, helping the Membership Department with mail outs, updating promotion mailing lists, updating program lists, and other general office tasks such as answering the phones, filing and copying.

Jennifer Henderson worked during the Summer 2007, Whitney Jarnagin worked during the Fall 2007, and Andrea Shonborn is currently working her internship with KWBU which began in February 2008 – all under the supervision of Ms. Paul.

KWBU-FM had one intern during the reporting period – Lauren Bauerle. Lauren began her internship with KWBU-FM in late February 2008 and is currently receiving instruction in how to construct a story and computer editing. After she completes this instruction she will be working on creating segments for KWBU's "Dot Org" segments – short features on local area non-profit organizations. She is working under the supervision of Derek Smith, KWBU-FM News and Public Affairs Director.

(d) Initiative: Participation in events sponsored by educational institutions

On November 5, 2007, Clare Paul, KWBU-TV Station Manager addressed a Baylor University Media Programming Class on the subject of managing a PBS television station, including programming issues, the differences between a PBS vs. a commercial station, and various media careers/opportunities available.

Business Affairs Manager Carla Hervey attended the Public Broadcasting Manager's Association (PBMA) Conference in New Orleans, Louisiana in May 2007 and was in attendance at the session on 5/31/07 entitled "Compliance 101." This session was presented by Bob Winteringham, the Corporation for Public Broadcasting's deputy inspector general and included information on requirements of the public broadcasting provisions of the Communications Act and FCC's rules, including equal employment opportunities.
