aMethods classes (MUS 1111, 1112, 1113, 1114, 1115, and 1116) should be taken in the prescribed sequence to avoid schedule conflicts with conducting classes (MUS 2260, 3260, and 4262) in the Junior and Senior years because of Majors ARE NOT required to take MUS 1119 but ARE required to a fifth credit of chamber music. This plan allows for a total of 51 hours in General Studies with a load of 18 hours each semester (except the student teaching semester). The General Studies requirement is 42-50 hours, depending on your prior foreign language study. If you are interested in taking fewer than 18 hours per semester then you are strongly encouraged to apply AP credits (when applicable), CLEP examination credit, or to take summer term courses, either at Baylor or at another approved institution. A maximum of 15 hours is transferable from another institution.
