

Summer 2011 Honor Code Violations Report

HONOR COUNCIL CASES:

Alleged Violation: Assisted another student during exam.

Date of Violation: 10/05/2010

Decision: Guilty

Sanction: Received an "F" for the course.

Alleged Violation: Submitted an earlier work for credit.

Date of Violation: 03/18/2011

Decision: Guilty

Sanction: Received an "F" for the course.

Alleged Violation: Invaded administrative security for preparation and storage of exams and obtained unauthorized information during an exam.

Date of Violation: 06/19/2011

Decision: Guilty

Sanction: Immediate expulsion. Notation required on transcript.

The remaining 4 reported violations from the Summer 2011 semester were resolved between the professor and the student. The results of those cases are as follows:

Alleged Violation: Plagiarism.

Date of Violation: 05/11/2011

Decision: Guilty

Sanction: Received a "0" on the paper.

Alleged Violation: Failed to follow instructions of Instructor in order to obtain an unfair academic advantage.

Date of Violation: 05/19/2011

Decision: Guilty

Sanction: Received a "0" for the quiz, will not be allowed to drop the grade, and was placed on a learning contract.

Alleged Violation: Plagiarism.

Date of Violation: 05/20/2011

Decision: Guilty

Sanction: Received an "F" for the course.

Alleged Violation: Falsified an academic document.

Date of Violation: 08/08/2011

Decision: Guilty

Sanction: Received an 'F' for the course.
