

PRE-ADVISEMENT CHECKLIST

You will not be advised by Honors-Program staff without a completed checklist, as per the instructions available on the program's Web site: www.baylor.edu/honors_program/index.php?id=22003.

- _____ 1. Identify the degree you are pursuing.
Examples: "BA," "BS," "BBA," "BSECE," "BM," "BSEd (Sec.)," "BA (Undecided)," "BS (Undecided)"

 - _____ 2. Identify your declared major field(s) and, if applicable, pre-professional program.
Examples: "English," "Mech. EGR," "Pre-Business," "Biochemistry/Pre-Med," "Biology/Pre-Dent," "Philosophy and Great Texts," "Theory," "Undecided"

 - _____ 3. Identify the potential Honors courses (including section numbers) for which you might register in the spring.
_____ -- Remember to follow the instructions listed on the "Advising" section of the Honors Program Web page: see URL above.
_____ -- "Undecided" students should identify courses that could apply to *more than one* of their prospective degrees/majors and for which they are qualified to register.
_____ -- Freshmen and sophomores should register for Honors courses that count toward their degree plan and/or major field; juniors and seniors will, in most cases, be registering for courses offered by the Honors Program (with HON prefixes).
[NOTE: In identifying required courses, sophomores and upper-div. students especially will find it useful to consult a personalized degree audit. See the "Advising" section of the Web page for details.]
