

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT BU-PP 708

Baylor University has a strong program to assist faculty members with research and teaching. The University has a program of Summer Sabbaticals, University Sabbaticals and Released Time Fellowships to support projects in teaching, research, and creation and performance in the arts. These programs are administered by the Office of the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs.

In addition, workshops in topics related to teaching are conducted each year. A special opportunity is available in the Summer Teaching Institute which meets for several weeks each summer to examine basic issues in teaching and to develop procedures for strengthening teaching skills. The Institute is administered through the Office of Continuing Education, Faculty & Staff Development.

The University Research Committee annually awards grants in support of faculty research projects. This program is administered through the Office of Research Administration.
