

Dia Dog Show Categories

- The dog show will consist of **3** separate competitions: best dressed, best trick, and people's choice. Each dog will be allowed to compete in each event regardless of their (I believe you should use "its" here) performance in other events, including the possibility of a single contestant winning all three events.
- The cost will be \$10 for the first event, and \$5 for each additional event.

Best Dressed:

- Judges will make assessments of dog's attire based upon appropriateness for breed, creativity, quality of apparel, and the dog's ability to walk or sit without removing the clothing.
- Contestants will be allowed, though not required, to show their dog in up to three different outfits and each will be judged independently.
- The contestant will only be allowed to count his or her highest score to enter the final round.
- The Final Round will consist of the top five contestants from the prior round, being judged along side each other, after which the Best Dressed will be named.

Best Trick:

- This competition will require dog owners to list no more than two tricks their dog can perform.
- Upon the day of competition, the contestants must have their dog perform its best trick at least twice within five minutes.
- The contestants will be judged based on the trick difficulty, dog responsiveness, timeliness of trick performance, and creativity.
- The five contestants with the most points will compete again in a final round.

People's Choice:

- The competition will require dog owners to provide three pictures of their dog, each in different settings.
 - No picture will be allowed that has recognizable people in it.
 - Contestants are encouraged to take pictures around Baylor's campus.

- On the day of Diadeloso, the student body will be allowed to vote for their favorite contestant. At 2:00 pm the top five contestants will be contacted and will receive a final judging by the celebrity judge panel.

On April 19th:

The panel of “celebrity judges” will narrow down each category to 5 finalists.

The finalists in each category will then perform their tricks or parade their costumes on the stage for all to see.

Then the judges will decide on 1st and 2nd place and prizes will be awarded.

For the People’s Choice, pictures of the dogs will be posted on the day of the event.

People can then come by and vote for their favorite contestant. Any ties will be broken by the panel of judges.
