**Theresa Seay
(1944-2011)**

Papers, 1964-2010

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Biographical Note:

Theresa Margaret Carroll Seay was born in New York City on August 28, 1943, the only child of Charles Edward Carroll and Stephania Klapik Carroll. Charles died when Theresa was six years old and she was raised by her mother. She was educated through high school in Catholic schools graduating from Notre Dame High School near the top of her class.



Theresa attended Washington State College in Machias, Maine, until the end of her sophomore year when she transferred to the University of Maine at Orono. She graduated with a bachelor's degree in history and education in 1965, and then attended graduate school for one semester.

She met and married Kenneth Edward Garnett in 1968 and settled near Ellsworth, Maine. They lived there for about 10 years. Their only child, David Edward, was born in 1973. During this time she joined Mensa. She worked for 10 years as a veterinary assistant in Ellsworth. She also bred German Shepherd dogs, Arabian horses, and operated a riding stable. She was active in local politics, although she never ran for office. At some point Theresa became interested in JFK assassination research. After studying the available information, she became an advocate for alternate explanations. She also, with her Mensa network, took part in demonstrations about injustices she encountered.

After a divorce, she and son David moved to Raleigh, North Carolina. In the Raleigh Mensa group, she met and subsequently married Robert Seay, an engineer at a local manufacturer of electronic components. She became a prominent member in this local Mensa group.

In 1988 Theresa and Robert moved to Asheville, North Carolina where she set up a consulting business. During the three years in Asheville, she wrote a number of articles and stories, some of which were published in various specialty magazines. She attended several conferences of JFK researchers and chaired one in Dallas on the 30th anniversary in 1993.



After moving to Connecticut, Theresa entered the graduate program at Western Connecticut University in Danbury in 1993. She finished the master's program there and was admitted to the University of Connecticut at Storrs for her doctoral studies. She was awarded her Ph.D. in History and Government in 2002. Her dissertation was about the discrepancies in the medical evidence between Parkland Hospital and the Bethesda autopsy of JFK.

After the 9-11 terrorist attacks, Theresa joined a local group of researchers where she put considerable effort into investigating and communicating with other colleagues. She continued this activity until her death on May 22, 2011.

Scope and Content Note:

In my thesis I intend to prove that the single bullet theory is totally without foundation and contrary to known facts and reason. Moreover, the [Warren] Commission knew it at the time and deliberately withheld evidence which would have negated their conclusions.

The Theresa Seay Papers combine over thirty years of research in the assassination of John F. Kennedy. The result of which included a master's thesis, a Ph.D dissertation, a newsletter run, and speaking engagements. Her research is rooted in the volumes of the Warren Commission, the House Select Committee on Assassinations, and numerous documents released by the FBI, CIA and other federal agencies since 1963. Seay amassed a large collection of books related to the Kennedy Assassination. Books have been cataloged and incorporated in the larger Poage Library JFK Collection available [here](#). Major topics include Kennedy assassination literature, conspiracies and cover-ups, the CIA and FBI.

The bulk of the collection is found in the Manuscript Material. Materials are arranged topically: **Conferences, Correspondence, Dissertation, Political Assassinations and Attempts, Publications, and Research.**

Conferences, 1992-1994

Conferences are arranged by date and items present include programs, schedules of events. Conferences include the Kennedy Assassination Conference, Second Research Conference of the Third Decade, and the Teach-In and Symposium of the 30th Anniversary of the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Dissertation, 1993-2002

In 2002, Seay completed her doctoral dissertation, "The Warren Commission and Beyond: The Question of Conspiracy in the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy." Material present include copies of each of the dissertation chapters, illustrations, defense notes and drafts of Seay's 1998 dissertation prospectus. Following the completion of her dissertation, Seay submitted a book proposal to Palgrave Publishing. The proposal, sample chapter and correspondence are present here. Also of note is Seay's master thesis prospectus (1993-1994) from Western Connecticut State University which served as the foundation to her dissertation.

JFK News Clippings, 1965-2000

Arranged by date, JFK News Clippings features thirty-five years of Kennedy related stories featured in the press.

Political Assassinations and Attempts, 1865-1993

Chiefly comprised of news clippings, this series serves as the foundation for Seay's first chapter in her dissertation. Material is arranged by person and includes clippings on Lincoln/Booth, Garfield, McKinley, the Roosevelts, Truman, Nixon, Ford, Reagan, John F. Kennedy and Robert F. Kennedy.

Publications, 1967-1999

Material is arranged by type-articles, book reviews, magazines, newsletters, and reports. Furthermore, articles and reports are grouped by subject. Of particular interest is Seay's own newsletter, "Assassinations-SIG/Target: Truth." Seay (nee Garnett) served as editor of her newsletter and it was published from 1977 to 1984.

Research, 1963-2002

The largest series, Research, served as Seay's "evidentiary base" for her dissertation and more broadly, to establish a need for further inquiry into the Kennedy assassination. Material is arranged by its source-Assassination Records Review Board documents 1963-1998, Internet Research 1994-2001, House Select Committee on Assassinations 1960-1992, National Archives 1964-2000, and the Warren Commission. Brief descriptions accompany the folder listings.

Lastly, a single box of **Media** is found within the collection. Cassettes, VHS tapes, and photographs are present. Of interest is a notebook of photographs from the Warren Commission investigation and the House Select Committee on Assassinations. *Note: some photographs contain graphic images.*
