Occupational Therapy Doctorate

The post-professional Occupational Therapy Doctorate currently requires 30-credit hours for completion: five Doctoral Capstone Project credits; seventeen Core Course credits; and eight Elective track credits. Recently we discovered a need to adjust our course structure and below is a breakdown of the proposed changes:

- Doctoral Capstone Project is currently five, one-credit hour courses for a total of 5-credit Hours of Doctoral Capstone. This series will be adjusted to three courses (two, two-credit courses and one, three-credit course) for a total of 7-credit hours;
- Elective tracks: currently eight credits are required for each elective track. This requirement will be reduced to six credits.
- The degree requirement remains at 30 credit hours.
