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Retention of Fall 2004 First-Time Freshmen: Six-Year Update

This study tracks the enrollment of 2,785 first-time freshmen that entered Baylor University during Summer and Fall 2004. Student data were examined for the period between Fall 2004 and Fall 2010. Summary information about retention and graduation rates is displayed by selected characteristics. Of the 2,785 first-time freshmen, 40 percent were males and 30 percent were students in racial and ethnic minority groups.

As depicted in Table 1, these first-time freshmen had the following enrollment pattern:

After entering the University in Fall 2004, 83.2 percent continued their enrollment in Fall 2005. In Fall 2006, 76 percent of the original students continued their enrollment. Within three years after entering Baylor, 2,018 (72.5%) remained enrolled, 724 (26.0%) had left the University, and 43 (1.5%) had graduated.

Within four years after entering Baylor:

1,398 (50.2%) had graduated,
764 (27.4%) left the University (attrition), and
623 (22.4%) remained enrolled.

Within five years after entering Baylor:

1,907 (68.5%) had graduated,
779 (28.0%) left the University (attrition), and
99 (3.6%) remained enrolled.

Within six years after entering Baylor:

1,976 (71.0%) had graduated,
766 (27.5%) left the University (attrition), and
43 (1.5%) remained enrolled.

Table 1 displays the general flow of enrollment for the first-time freshmen that entered Baylor in Summer and Fall 2004. These students are displayed by gender, racial/ethnic group, minority status, Baptist affiliation, Texas status, citizen status, first generation college student status, highest entrance test score*, high school class quartile, and academic index. Retention, attrition, and graduation rates are listed for this six-year period. The reader is reminded that the attrition statistics include those students who completely withdrew from school as well as those who elected to enroll at other postsecondary institutions. The table also appropriately accounts for those students who "stopped out" and later returned to reenroll in the University. A graphic summary of this enrollment flow across the entire six years is displayed in Figure 1.

Tables 2 and 3 display enrollment status by each of the following characteristics: highest entrance test score interval, high school class quartile, racial/ethnic group, and gender. Demographic data are also presented in the report "Profile of Freshman Class, Fall 2003 and Fall 2004" *IRT Series*, Vol. 04-05, No. 22.

* Some students submitted scores for both SAT and ACT entrance tests. For this report, each student's highest SAT score was compared to the student's highest ACT score, and only the better score was retained.

Provisionally Admitted First-Time Freshmen

Of the 2,785 first-time freshmen, there were 263 (9.4%) who were provisionally admitted to the University. (This excludes the athletes coded as provisional.) Among these 263 students, 130 were ranked in the top half of their high school graduation classes, 113 were ranked in the bottom half, and 20 did not have a high school class ranking.

As depicted in Table 4, these provisionally admitted students had the following enrollment pattern:

After entering the University in Fall 2004, 58.9 percent continued their enrollment in Fall 2005. In Fall 2006, 51.0 percent of these students continued their enrollment. Within three years after entering Baylor, 130 (49.4%) remained enrolled, 129 (49.0%) had left the University, and 4 (1.5%) had graduated.

Within four years after entering Baylor:

68	(25.9%)	had graduated,
133	(50.6%)	left the University (attrition), and
62	(23.6%)	remained enrolled.

Within five years after entering Baylor:

108	(41.1%)	had graduated,
139	(52.9%)	left the University (attrition), and
16	(6.1%)	remained enrolled.

Within six years after entering Baylor:

117	(44.5%)	had graduated,
138	(52.5%)	left the University (attrition), and
8	(3.0%)	remained enrolled.

A graphic summary of this enrollment flow across the entire six years is displayed in Figure 2. Additional information about these 263 provisionally admitted students is displayed in Tables 5 and 6. Some of the subgroups are small and, therefore, retention and graduation percentages, as well as means and even medians must be interpreted accordingly. The information in these tables was included for general perusal by the reader, but no statistical analyses were performed. The formats of these tables are similar to those of Tables 2 and 3.

Entrance Test Scores and High School Class Quartile

High school performance and entrance test scores are the most important early predictors of student retention (Astin et al., 1987). Table 7 is a tabulation of the Fall 2004 first-time freshmen by entrance test score and high school class quartile. The top half of Table 7 displays the 1,717 students who had both an SAT score and a high school class quartile ranking. The bottom half of the table shows the 783 students who had both an ACT score and a high school class quartile ranking. Table 8 displays the four-year graduation rates for these two groups of students. Table 9 displays the five-year graduation rates and Table 10 displays the six-year graduation rates. For example, of the 335 students who had an SAT score of 1300 or more and were in the first quartile of their high school class (Table 7), 69.9 percent graduated from the University within four years (Table 8); 81.8 percent graduated from the University within five years (Table 9); and 82.4 percent graduated from the University within six years (Table 10).

Most Recent Ending Cumulative GPA

Tables 11 and 12 display the most recent ending cumulative grade point average (GPA) for first-time freshmen and provisionally admitted students. The GPAs are shown for the three groupings of student status – continuing students, non-returning students, and graduated students. The GPAs for the graduated students are higher than the continuing and non-returning students.

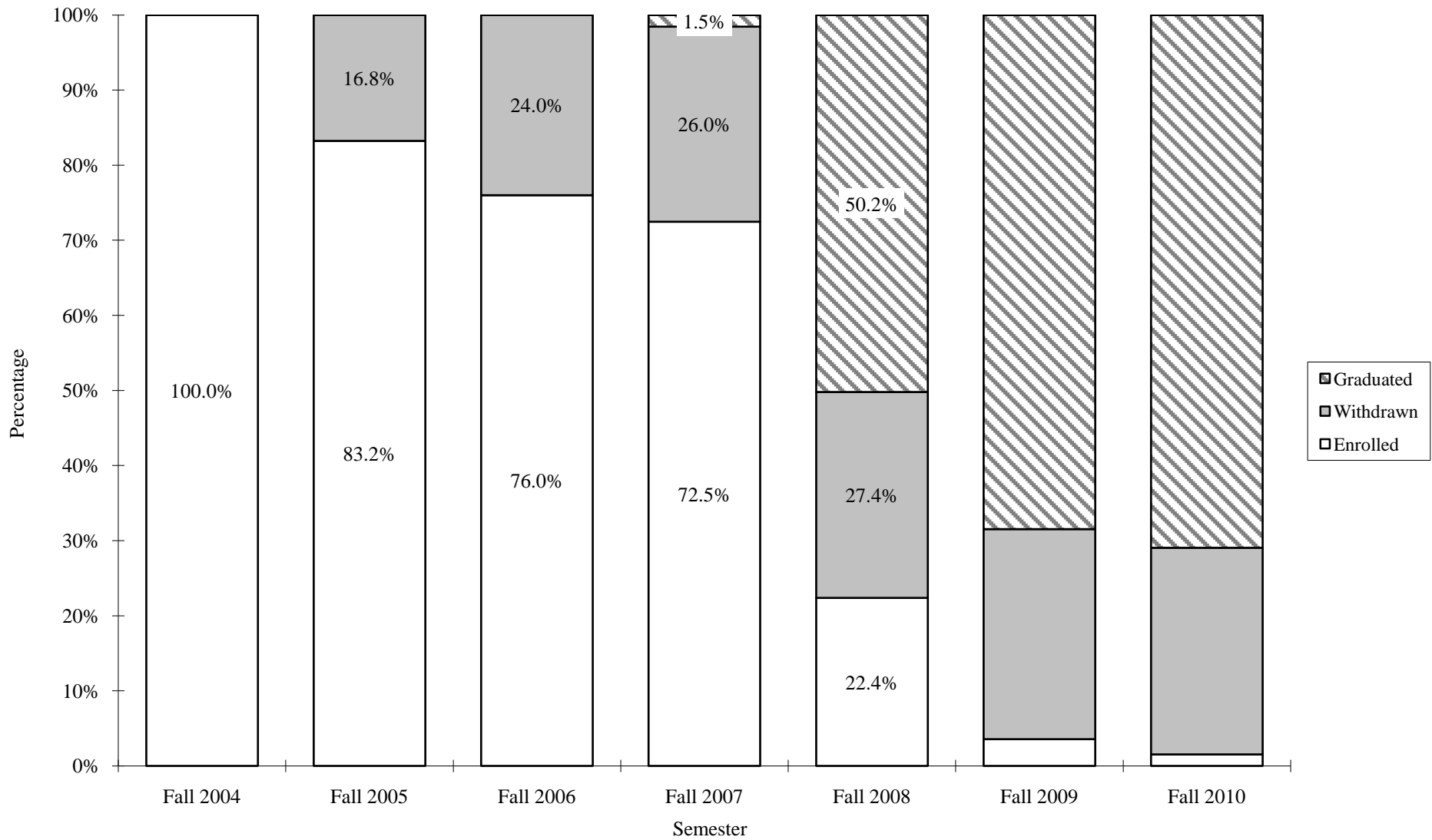

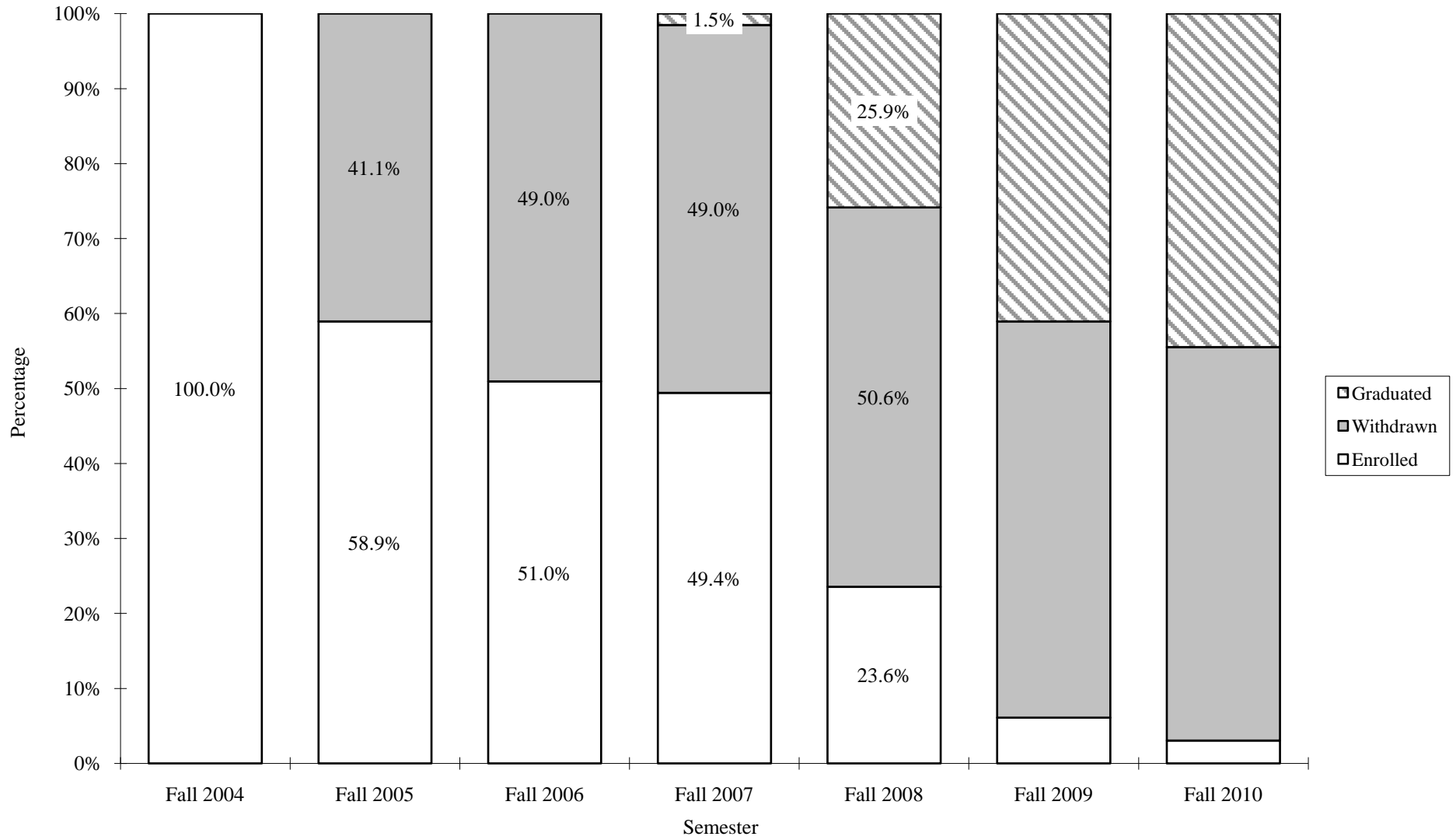
