This report contains current information about graduation rates and the one-year retention rate for first-time freshmen at Baylor. Each of the rates is based on the five most current year's data.

Graduation Rates

<i>What percentage of first-time freshmen graduate <u>within three</u> years?</i>	2%
<i>What percentage of first-time freshmen graduate <u>within four</u> years?</i>	52%
<i>What percentage of first-time freshmen graduate <u>within five</u> years?</i>	70%
<i>What percentage of first-time freshmen graduate <u>within six</u> years?</i>	71%
