### Graduation Rates and One-Year Retention of First-Time Freshmen

This report contains current information about graduation rates and the one-year retention rate for first-time freshmen at Baylor. The rates are based on the five most current year's data.

#### Graduation Rates

<i>What percentage of first-time freshmen graduate in <u>three</u> years?</i>	<b>1%</b>
<i>What percentage of first-time freshmen graduate within <u>four</u> years?</i>	<b>45%</b>
<i>What percentage of first-time freshmen graduate within <u>five</u> years?</i>	<b>68%</b>
<i>What percentage of first-time freshmen graduate within <u>six</u> years?</i>	<b>71%</b>
