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### **Profile of Undergraduate Transfers Fall 2017 and Fall 2018**

This report contains descriptive information about the entering undergraduate transfer students enrolled in Fall 2017 and Fall 2018. In this report, transfers who initially enrolled in Summer 2017 or 2018 and continued in the respective fall term are classified as entering transfers and are included in the population. Included in this report is additional information about the following topics:

#### **Fall 2018**

The largest group of the 352 transfers entered Baylor as sophomores (50.9%). Fifty-seven percent of the transfer students are females. Forty-six percent of the students are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation comprise 18 percent of the group, 25 percent are Christian with no affiliation, and 18 percent are Catholic.

Eighty-five percent of these students are United States citizens, while 52 (15%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 15 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' home addresses, the undergraduate transfer class is comprised of students from 33 states. Texas is the home address state for 60 percent of the students.

#### **Fall 2017**

The largest group of the 366 transfers entered Baylor as sophomores (54.6%). Fifty-seven percent of the transfer students are females. Forty-nine percent of the students are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation comprise 21 percent of the group, 27 percent are Christian with no affiliation, and 15 percent are Catholic.

Eighty-eight percent of these students are United States citizens, while 44 (12%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 7 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' home addresses, the undergraduate transfer class is comprised of students from 31 states. Texas is the home address state for 66 percent of the students.

In the first table, students are counted in only one race/ethnic group category. If the student indicated “yes” to the first question, the student was categorized as Hispanic (only) regardless of any race code(s) they may have selected. If the student marked more than one race (and “no” to Hispanic/Latino in the first question), he/she was reported in the category of Multiracial. The second table counts a student in every race/ethnic group category he/she selected. The percentages in this table are based on the headcount of students.
