Fall 2018

The law school enrollment of 431 includes 111 new students. Fifty-three percent of the law students are males, and 26 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Twenty-one percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

The law student body is comprised of 424 United States citizens, 6 resident aliens, and 1 nonresident alien. The foreign students represent 5 countries. The score range for the middle fifty percent of law students who took the LSAT is 156 - 161 with a mean of 159.

Fall 2017

The law school enrollment of 385 includes 87 new students. Fifty percent of the law students are males, and 27 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Twenty-one percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

The law student body is comprised of 377 United States citizens, 7 resident aliens, and 1 nonresident alien. The foreign students represent 6 countries. The score range for the middle fifty percent of law students who took the LSAT is 157 - 162 with a mean of 159.

* In this report, two race/ethnic group tables are presented. When providing information on their race and ethnicity, students were asked two questions. The first question asked the student: Are you Hispanic/Latino? The second question allowed students to select among five race categories, with multiple responses allowed. In the first table, students are counted in only one race/ethnic group category. If the student indicated “yes” to the first question, the student was categorized as Hispanic (only) regardless of any race code(s) they may have selected. If the student marked more than one race (and “no” to Hispanic/Latino in the first question), he/she was reported in the category of Multiracial. The second table counts a student in every race/ethnic group category he/she selected. The percentages in this table are based on the headcount of students.
