## **Profile of Law Students Fall 2018 and Fall 2019**

### **Fall 2019**

The law school enrollment of 479 includes 104 new students. Fifty percent of the law students are males, and 26 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Twenty-two percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

The law student body is comprised of 477 United States citizens, one resident alien, and one nonresident alien. The foreign students represent two countries. The score range for the middle fifty percent of law students who took the LSAT is 156 - 161 with a mean of 159.

### **Fall 2018**

The law school enrollment of 431 includes 111 new students. Fifty-three percent of the law students are males, and 26 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Twenty-one percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

The law student body is comprised of 424 United States citizens, six resident aliens, and one nonresident alien. The foreign students represent five countries. The score range for the middle fifty percent of law students who took the LSAT is 156 - 161 with a mean of 159.
