Profile of Undergraduate Transfers Fall 2018 and Fall 2019

This report contains descriptive information about the entering undergraduate transfer students enrolled in Fall 2018 and Fall 2019. In this report, transfers who initially enrolled in Summer 2018 or 2019 and continued in the respective fall term are classified as entering transfers and are included in the population. Included in this report is additional information about the following topics:

Fall 2019

The largest group of the 353 transfers entered Baylor as sophomores (51.3%). Fifty-five percent of the transfer students are females. Fifty-three percent of the students are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation comprise 14 percent of the group, 24 percent are Christian with no affiliation, and 20 percent are Catholic.

Eighty-five percent of these students are United States citizens, while 53 (15%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 16 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' home addresses, the undergraduate transfer class is comprised of students from 20 states. Texas is the home address state for 69 percent of the students.

Fall 2018

The largest group of the 352 transfers entered Baylor as sophomores (50.9%). Fifty-seven percent of the transfer students are females. Forty-six percent of the students are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation comprise 18 percent of the group, 25 percent are Christian with no affiliation, and 18 percent are Catholic.

Eighty-five percent of these students are United States citizens, while 52 (15%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 15 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' home addresses, the undergraduate transfer class is comprised of students from 33 states. Texas is the home address state for 60 percent of the students.
