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Profile of Non-Returning Freshmen Using National Student Clearinghouse Data Fall 2018 to Fall 2019

Executive Summary

This report contains descriptive information about first-time freshman students who were enrolled at Baylor University during Fall 2018 but did not return in Fall 2019.

- Of the 3,366 first-time freshmen enrolled in Fall 2018, 2,974 (88.4%) returned in Fall 2019 and 392 (11.6%) did not return.
- Subsequent enrollment at another institution for the non-returning students was tracked using data from the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC). Detailed records containing identifying information about the students are only returned by NSC if the student has not blocked that information.
- Of the 392 first-time freshmen who did not return, the NSC had Fall 2019 detailed enrollment information on 268 (68.4%) of these students. The largest group of those students tracked by NSC enrolled at four-year public institutions.
- Of those students tracked by NSC, 16 (6.0%) enrolled at McLennan Community College in Fall 2019.
- In general, students who retained at Baylor had higher entrance test scores and high school quartiles than those students who did not return.

Detailed Report

This report contains descriptive information about first-time freshman students who were enrolled at Baylor University during Fall 2018 but did not return in Fall 2019. Included in this report is information about the following topics:

There were 3,366 first-time freshman students enrolled in Fall 2018. Of these students, 2,974 (88.4%) returned in Fall 2019 and 392 (11.6%) did not return. In order to seek additional information on the students who did not return, the Office of Institutional Research & Testing (IRT) submitted a file of these students to the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC). The NSC is a national repository of student records used for student degree and enrollment verification. The “Student Tracker” service from the NSC enables institutions to tap the nation’s largest enrollment database and track where students ultimately enroll.

Student Tracker provides enrollment data from more than 3,600 institutions representing over 97% of national postsecondary enrollment.

This report contains information only on non-returning first-time freshman students for which IRT received detailed subsequent enrollment records from NSC. If a student has placed a block on their information, the NSC does not return detailed records for that student. IRT submitted the file of the 392 non-returning students. The NSC had Fall 2019 enrollment information on 268 (68.4%) of these students. NSC provided information for each of these students including institution of matriculation, matriculation dates, institution type, and institution location.

The largest group of the non-returning students tracked using the NSC data enrolled in public four-year institutions. Table 1 breaks down enrollment by type of institution.

Appendix I contains detailed information for the Fall 2018 first-time freshman students who returned to Baylor in Fall 2019 compared to those who did not return. The entire population of non-returning students (392) is examined as well as those students who were tracked by NSC according to institution type as defined in Table 1. Appendix II contains detailed information for students who enrolled at one of the top four transferring institutions as tracked by NSC.

Table 2 provides a summary of biographic and demographic information for Fall 2018 first-time freshmen who returned to Baylor in Fall 2019 compared to students who did not return to Baylor. See Appendix I for details. A smaller percentage of students who did not return were female (60.5%) compared to students who re-enrolled at Baylor (62.3%). A larger percentage of students who did not return were minorities (45.4%) compared to students who returned to Baylor (35.4%). Additionally, a smaller percentage of students who did not return were Baptist (23.5%) as compared to those students who returned to Baylor (25.2%).

Table 3 provides a summary of academic information for Fall 2018 first-time freshmen who returned to Baylor in Fall 2019 compared to students who did not return to Baylor. See Appendix I for details. The average SAT score of students who returned to Baylor was higher (1284) than the average SAT score of students who did not return to Baylor (1228). Additionally, a larger percentage of students who returned to Baylor were in the first quartile of their high school (73.6%) than those students who did not return to Baylor (64.7%).

Table 4 lists the top nineteen transferring institutions tracked by the National Student Clearinghouse. These nineteen institutions account for 46.6% of the students that enrolled at other institutions that are tracked by NSC. The list includes number of students who were enrolled at Baylor in Fall 2018 but enrolled at the transferring institution in Fall 2019, type of institution, and location of institution.

Table 5 provides a summary of biographic and demographic information for Fall 2018 first-time freshmen who returned to Baylor in Fall 2019 compared to non-returning students who enrolled at the top four transferring institutions. See Appendix II for details. A smaller percentage of students who returned to Baylor in Fall 2019 were minorities (35.4%) than the percentages of minorities that transferred to three of the top four transferring institutions. Additionally, smaller percentage of students who returned to Baylor in Fall 2019 were from Texas (61.2%) than the percentages of Texas students that transferred to the top four transferring institutions.

Table 6 provides a summary of academic information for Fall 2018 first-time freshmen who returned to Baylor in Fall 2019 compared to non-returning students who enrolled at the top four transferring institutions. See Appendix II for details. The average SAT score of students who returned to Baylor in Fall 2019 (1284) was higher than the average SAT score of students who enrolled at the top four transferring institutions. Additionally, a larger percentage of students who returned to Baylor in Fall 2019 were in the first quartile of their high school class (73.6%) as compared to those who enrolled at three of the top four transferring institutions.
