## Profile of Undergraduate Students Fall 2019 and Fall 2020

This report contains descriptive information about undergraduate students for Fall 2019 and Fall 2020. Included in this report is information about the following topics:

### Fall 2020

The undergraduate enrollment of 14,399 includes 222 students classified as Non-Degree or Postbaccalaureate. There are 3,731 first-time freshmen and 357 new transfer students. Sixty percent of these undergraduates are females, and 38.2 percent of the students are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation comprise 23.6 percent of the group, while 19.5 percent indicated they are Christian (No Affiliation) and 16.6 percent are Catholics.

Ninety-four percent of these students are U.S. citizens, while 851 (5.9%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 76 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' home addresses, there are undergraduates from all 50 states and the District of Columbia. Sixty-four percent of the students are from Texas.

Among students with a reported high school class ranking, 44.8 percent were in the top 10% of their high school graduating classes. The score range for the middle fifty percent of undergraduates is 1200 – 1360 with a mean score of 1280 for the Redesigned SAT and 26 - 31 with a mean score of 28.5 for the ACT examination.

### Fall 2019

The undergraduate enrollment of 14,108 includes 287 students classified as Non-Degree or Postbaccalaureate. There are 3,307 first-time freshmen and 353 new transfer students. Sixty percent of these undergraduates are females, and 37.7 percent of the students are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation comprise 24.7 percent of the group, while 19.6 percent indicated they are Christian (No Affiliation) and 16.9 percent are Catholics.

Ninety-four percent of these students are U.S. citizens, while 868 (6.2%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 74 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' home addresses, there are undergraduates from 49 states and the District of Columbia. Sixty-four percent of the students are from Texas.

Among students with a reported high school class ranking, 42.3 percent were in the top 10% of their high school graduating classes. The score range for the middle fifty percent of undergraduates is 1200 – 1360 with a mean score of 1280 for the Redesigned SAT and 26 - 31 with a mean score of 28.3 for the ACT examination.
