Profile of Undergraduate Transfers Fall 2019 and Fall 2020

This report contains descriptive information about the entering undergraduate transfer students enrolled in Fall 2019 and Fall 2020. In this report, transfers who initially enrolled in Summer 2019 or 2020 and continued in the respective fall term are classified as entering transfers and are included in the population. Included in this report is additional information about the following topics:

Fall 2020

The largest group of the 357 transfers entered Baylor as sophomores (51.3%). Fifty-six percent of the transfer students are females. Forty-seven percent of the students are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with Christian (no affiliation) comprise 26 percent of the group, 20 percent are Baptist, and 16 percent are Catholic.

Ninety-two percent of these students are United States citizens, while 27 (8%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 13 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' home addresses, the undergraduate transfer class is comprised of students from 28 states. Texas is the home address state for 72 percent of the students.

Fall 2019

The largest group of the 353 transfers entered Baylor as sophomores (51.3%). Fifty-five percent of the transfer students are females. Fifty-three percent of the students are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with Christian (no affiliation) comprise 24 percent of the group, 20 percent are Catholic, and 14 percent are Baptist.

Eighty-five percent of these students are United States citizens, while 53 (15%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 16 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' home addresses, the undergraduate transfer class is comprised of students from 20 states. Texas is the home address state for 69 percent of the students.
