Profile of Social Work Graduate Students Fall 2019 and Fall 2020

This report contains descriptive information about graduate students enrolled in the School of Social Work in Fall 2019 and Fall 2020. If a student is in a dual career such as MDV/MSW, the student is counted in each program (i.e., program count).

Fall 2020

The program count of 348 includes 37 males and 311 females. Thirty-seven percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups and 22 percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination. Twenty-one students are enrolled in the Seminary/Social Work dual program.

The Social Work student body is comprised of 337 United States citizens, five resident aliens, and six nonresident aliens. The foreign students represent nine foreign countries. Part-time students make up 11.5 percent of the student body. The average credit hour load for social work students is 11.0.

Fall 2019

The program count of 282 includes 25 males and 257 females. Thirty-eight percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups and 31 percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination. Twenty-two students are enrolled in dual programs. Specifically, 21 are Seminary/Social Work students while one is a Social Work/Graduate School student.

The Social Work student body is comprised of 272 United States citizens, two resident aliens, and eight nonresident aliens. The foreign students represent eight foreign countries. Part-time students make up 11 percent of the student body. The average credit hour load for social work students is 12.1.
