Profile of Undergraduate Transfers Fall 2020 and Fall 2021

This report contains descriptive information about the entering undergraduate transfer students enrolled in Fall 2020 and Fall 2021. In this report, transfers who initially enrolled in Summer 2020 or 2021 and continued in the respective fall term are classified as entering transfers and are included in the population. Included in this report is additional information about the following topics:

Fall 2021

The largest group of the 364 transfers entered Baylor as sophomores (50.0%). Fifty-eight percent of the transfer students are females. Forty-six percent of the students are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with Christian (no affiliation) comprise 31 percent of the group, 16 percent are Baptist, and 16 percent are Catholic.

Ninety-four percent of these students are United States citizens, while 23 (6.3%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 12 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' home addresses, the undergraduate transfer class is comprised of students from 30 states. Texas is the home address state for 60 percent of the students.

Fall 2020

The largest group of the 357 transfers entered Baylor as sophomores (51.3%). Fifty-six percent of the transfer students are females. Forty-seven percent of the students are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with Christian (no affiliation) comprise 26 percent of the group, 20 percent are Baptist, and 16 percent are Catholic.

Ninety-two percent of these students are United States citizens, while 27 (7.6%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 13 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' home addresses, the undergraduate transfer class is comprised of students from 28 states. Texas is the home address state for 72 percent of the students.
