## **Profile of Social Work Graduate Students Fall 2008 and Fall 2009**

This report contains descriptive information about graduate students enrolled in the School of Social Work as their primary or secondary program in Fall 2008 and Fall 2009. If a student is in a dual career such as MDV/MSW, the student is counted in each program (i.e., program count).

### **Fall 2009**

There are a total of 122 School of Social Work graduate students in Fall 2009. Of these, 57 are new graduate social work students and 12 are new seminary students. Eighteen percent of the students are males, and 32 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Fifty-seven percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination. Ninety percent of these students are United States citizens, while 12 (9.8%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 9 foreign countries.

### **Fall 2008**

There are a total of 117 School of Social Work graduate students in Fall 2008. Of these, 60 are new graduate social work students and 9 are new seminary students. Fifteen percent of the students are males, and 29 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Sixty-four percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination. Ninety-two percent of these students are United States citizens, while 10 (8.5%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 9 foreign countries.
