The class of 3,098 first-time freshmen includes students who entered the University during Summer 2009 and Fall 2009. Twenty-eight percent of the class attended all of the Welcome Week activities. Minority students made up 35% of first-time freshmen, but 41% of the students that did not attend any Welcome Week activities were minority students.

It appears that first-time freshmen entering with higher academic indicators have a tendency to attend more Welcome Week activities.
