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Profile of Baylor Interdisciplinary Core (BIC) Students, Fall 2010

The Baylor Interdisciplinary Core (BIC) option for the general education degree requirements began in the fall of 1995. The Baylor Bulletin describes the BIC program as an attempt to “. . . integrate various academic disciplines with a set of comprehensive interdisciplinary courses to provide a coherent approach to learning.” This profile contains descriptive information about students in the program for Fall 2010 with comparison information for all undergraduate students. Please note that BIC students are included in the undergraduate totals.

There is a total BIC enrollment for the fall term of 554 students. Of these, 36 percent are male and 39 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Ninety-six percent of students in the BIC program are U.S. citizens (only 8 are international students and 17 have permanent residency in the United States). There are 182 first-time freshmen enrolled in the BIC program for the Fall 2010 semester.

Among the BIC students with a reported high school class ranking, 84 percent were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes. The score range for the middle fifty percent of the students in the BIC program is 1210 – 1360 with a mean score of 1284 for the SAT and 27 – 30 with a mean score of 28.5 for the ACT examination.

In order to fulfill new federal government reporting requirements on race and ethnicity, students were given the opportunity to select multiple race categories. In addition, Pacific Islander was designated as its own category (separate from Asian). The students were asked two questions. The first question asked the student “Are you Hispanic/Latino?” The second question allowed students to select among five race categories, with multiple responses allowed.

In this report, two race/ethnic group tables are presented. In the first table, students are counted in only one race/ethnic group category. If the student indicated “yes” to the first question, the student was categorized as Hispanic (only) regardless of any race code(s) they may have selected. If the student marked more than one race (and “no” to Hispanic/Latino in the first question), he/she was reported in the category of Multiracial. The second table counts a student in every race/ethnic group category he/she selected. The percentages in this table are based on the headcount of students.
