Profile of Fall 2010 Undergraduate Students Indicating an Interest in Vocational Christian Ministry

When students make application to Baylor they are asked to indicate their interest in various vocational Christian ministries. Students may update their interest on BearWeb as they continue their academic career at Baylor. This profile contains descriptive information about undergraduate students indicating an interest in at least one of the listed ministries with comparison information for all undergraduate students. Please note that students with a ministry interest are included in the undergraduate totals. Included in this report is information about the following topics:

There are a total of 2,055 undergraduate students enrolled in Fall 2010 indicating an interest in vocational Christian ministry. Of these students with a ministry interest, 42 percent are male and 30 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Ninety-six percent of these students are U.S. citizens (45 are international students and 43 have permanent residency in the United States). Below is a table indicating all of the ministries selected by undergraduate students. Please note that this is a duplicated count (students may have chosen more than one ministry).

* In order to fulfill new federal government reporting requirements on race and ethnicity, students were given the opportunity to select multiple race categories. In addition, Pacific Islander was designated as its own category (separate from Asian). The students were asked two questions. The first question asked the student "Are you Hispanic/Latino?" The second question allowed students to select among five race categories, with multiple responses allowed.

In this report, two race/ethnic group tables are presented. In the first table, students are counted in only one race/ethnic group category. If the student indicated "yes" to the first question, the student was categorized as Hispanic (only) regardless of any race code(s) they may have selected. If the student marked more than one race (and "no" to Hispanic/Latino in the first question), he/she was reported in the category of Multiracial. The second table counts a student in every race/ethnic group category he/she selected. The percentages in this table are based on the headcount of students.
