### Graduation Rates and One-Year Retention of First-Time Freshmen

This report contains current information about graduation rates and the one-year retention rate for first-time freshmen at Baylor. Each of the rates is based on the five most current year's data.

#### Graduation Rates

<i>What percentage of first-time freshmen graduate <u>within three</u> years?</i>	<b>2%</b>
<i>What percentage of first-time freshmen graduate <u>within four</u> years?</i>	<b>51%</b>
<i>What percentage of first-time freshmen graduate <u>within five</u> years?</i>	<b>69%</b>
<i>What percentage of first-time freshmen graduate <u>within six</u> years?</i>	<b>72%</b>
