Baylor Welcome Week includes four days of activities to introduce students to life at Baylor. This report contains descriptive information about first-time freshman and transfer Welcome Week attendees for Fall 2010. Included in this report is information about the following topics:

The class of 3,259 first-time freshmen includes students who entered the University during Summer 2010 and Fall 2010. Thirty-five percent of the class attended all of the Welcome Week activities. This figure increased from Fall 2009 when 28% attended all activities. Minority students made up 36% of first-time freshmen, but 41% of the students that did not attend any Welcome Week activities were minority students.

It appears that first-time freshmen entering with higher academic indicators have a tendency to attend more Welcome Week activities.

* In order to fulfill new federal government reporting requirements on race and ethnicity, students were given the opportunity to select multiple race categories. In addition, Pacific Islander was designated as its own category (separate from Asian). The students were asked two questions. The first question asked the student “Are you Hispanic/Latino?” The second question allowed students to select among five race categories, with multiple responses allowed.

In this report, two race/ethnic group tables are presented. In the first table, students are counted in only one race/ethnic group category. If the student indicated “yes” to the first question, the student was categorized as Hispanic (only) regardless of any race code(s) they may have selected. If the student marked more than one race (and “no” to Hispanic/Latino in the first question), he/she was reported in the category of Multiracial. The second table counts a student in every race/ethnic group category he/she selected. The percentages in this table are based on the headcount of students.
