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Profile of Seminary Students Fall 2010 and Fall 2011

Fall 2011

The program count of 356 includes 228 males and 128 females. There are 319 masters students and 37 doctoral students. Twenty-seven percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups and 94 percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination. There are 42 dual program students.

The seminary student body is comprised of 333 United States citizens, 5 resident aliens, and 18 nonresident aliens. The foreign students represent 12 foreign countries.

Part-time students make up 20 percent of the seminary student body. The average credit hour load for seminary students is 9.5.

Fall 2010

The program count of 369 includes 234 males and 135 females. There are 330 masters students and 39 doctoral students. Twenty-seven percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups and 95 percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination. There are 49 dual program students.

The seminary student body is comprised of 342 United States citizens, 4 resident aliens, and 23 nonresident aliens. The foreign students represent 11 foreign countries.

Part-time students make up 22 percent of the seminary student body. The average credit hour load for seminary students is 9.5.

* In order to fulfill new federal government reporting requirements on race and ethnicity, students were given the opportunity to select multiple race categories. In addition, Pacific Islander was designated as its own category (separate from Asian). The students were asked two questions. The first question asked the student "Are you Hispanic/Latino?" The second question allowed students to select among five race categories, with multiple responses allowed.

In this report, two race/ethnic group tables are presented. In the first table, students are counted in only one race/ethnic group category. If the student indicated "yes" to the first question, the student was categorized as Hispanic (only) regardless of any race code(s) they may have selected. If the student marked more than one race (and "no" to Hispanic/Latino in the first question), he/she was reported in the category of Multiracial. The second table counts a student in every race/ethnic group category he/she selected. The percentages in this table are based on the headcount of students.
