Profile of Fall 2012 Undergraduate Students Indicating an Interest in Vocational Christian Ministry

When students make application to Baylor they are asked to indicate their interest in various vocational Christian ministries. Students may update their interest on BearWeb as they continue their academic career at Baylor. This profile contains descriptive information about undergraduate students indicating an interest in at least one of the listed ministries with comparison information for all undergraduate students. Please note that students with a ministry interest are included in the undergraduate totals.

There are a total of 2,039 undergraduate students enrolled in Fall 2012 indicating an interest in vocational Christian ministry. Below is a table indicating all of the ministries selected by undergraduate students. Please note that this is a duplicated count (students may have chosen more than one ministry). The interests most often selected were “Missions” (n=716) and “Youth” (n=417).

Demographic statistics for students with a ministry interest closely resemble the undergraduate student body. Thirty-eight percent of the ministry students are male, while 41 percent of the undergraduates are male. The percentage of minority students with a ministry interest is slightly lower (32.9%) than the undergraduate population (35.1%).

* In order to fulfill new federal government reporting requirements on race and ethnicity, students were given the opportunity to select multiple race categories. In addition, Pacific Islander was designated as its own category (separate from Asian). The students were asked two questions. The first question asked the student "Are you Hispanic/Latino?" The second question allowed students to select among five race categories, with multiple responses allowed.

In this report, two race/ethnic group tables are presented. In the first table, students are counted in only one race/ethnic group category. If the student indicated "yes" to the first question, the student was categorized as Hispanic (only) regardless of any race code(s) they may have selected. If the student marked more than one race (and "no" to Hispanic/Latino in the first question), he/she was reported in the category of Multiracial. The second table counts a student in every race/ethnic group category he/she selected. The percentages in this table are based on the headcount of students.
