Fall 2004

The graduate enrollment of 1,297 includes 7 students classified as Graduate Nondegree. There are 446 new graduate students. Just over fifty-one (51.5) percent of the graduate enrollment are males, and 27.1 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Of the 1,125 students for whom religious affiliation data were available, 40.4% are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

Eighty-three percent of these students are United States citizens, while 222 (17.2%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 50 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' permanent addresses, the graduate student body comprises students from 41 states. Texas is the permanent address for approximately 70 percent of the students. The score range for the middle fifty percent of graduate students is 1000 - 1240 with a mean of 1120 for the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) and 530 - 640 with a mean of 588 for the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT).

Fall 2003

The graduate enrollment of 1,291 includes 10 students classified as Graduate Nondegree. There are 448 new graduate students. Just over fifty (50.5) percent of the graduate enrollment are males, and 25.3 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Of the 858 students for whom religious affiliation data were available, 46% are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

Eighty-three percent of these students are United States citizens, while 214 (16.5%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 56 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' permanent addresses, the graduate student body comprises students from 38 states. Texas is the permanent address for approximately 68 percent of the students. The score range for the middle fifty percent of graduate students is 980 - 1230 with a mean of 1104 for the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) and 540 - 650 with a mean of 591 for the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT).
