Fall 2004

The seminary enrollment of 391 includes 258 males and 133 females. There are 345 students enrolled in the Master of Divinity program, and 43 enrolled in the Doctor of Ministry program. Approximately 18 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups and 95 percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

The seminary student body is comprised of 368 United States citizens, 9 resident aliens, and 14 nonresident aliens. The foreign students represent seventeen foreign countries. Texas is the permanent address state for 85 percent of the students.

Part-time students make up 22 percent of the seminary student body. The average credit hour load for seminary students is 9.6.

Fall 2003

The seminary enrollment of 379 includes 249 males and 130 females. There are 337 students enrolled in the Master of Divinity program, and 41 enrolled in the Doctor of Ministry program. Approximately 15 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups and 87 percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

The seminary student body is comprised of 356 United States citizens, 12 resident aliens, and 11 nonresident aliens. The foreign students represent fourteen foreign countries. Texas is the permanent address state for 86 percent of the students.

Part-time students make up 22 percent of the seminary student body. The average credit hour load for seminary students is 9.6.
