### **Profile of Baylor Interdisciplinary Core (BIC) Students, Fall 2004**

The Baylor Interdisciplinary Core (BIC) option for the general education degree requirements began in the fall of 1995. The Baylor Bulletin describes the BIC program as an attempt to "... integrate various academic disciplines with a set of comprehensive interdisciplinary courses to provide a coherent approach to learning." This profile contains descriptive information about students in the program for Fall 2004 with comparison information for all undergraduate students. Please note that BIC students are included in the undergraduate totals.

There is a total BIC enrollment for the fall term of 683 students. Of these, 32 percent are male and 68 percent are female. Twenty-five percent of the BIC students are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Ninety-eight percent of students in the BIC program are U.S. citizens (only 4 are international students and 7 have permanent residency in the United States). There are 180 first-time BIC students for the Fall 2004 semester. Among the BIC students with a reported high school class ranking, 81 percent were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes.
