### Profile of Fall 2004 Undergraduate Students Indicating an Interest in Vocational Christian Ministry

When students make application to Baylor they are asked to indicate their interest in various vocational Christian ministries. Students may also update their interest on BearWeb. This profile contains descriptive information about undergraduate students indicating an interest in at least one of the listed ministries with comparison information for all undergraduate students. Please note that ministry students are included in the undergraduate totals.

There are a total of 1,895 students enrolled in Fall 2004 indicating an interest in vocational Christian ministry. Of these, 41 percent are male and 59 percent are female. Twenty-five percent of the ministry students are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Ninety-seven percent of these students are U.S. citizens (31 are international students and 33 have permanent residency in the United States). Below is a table indicating the ministries selected by undergraduate students. Please note that this is a duplicated count (students may have chosen more than one ministry).
