Fall 2018

The class of 3,366 first-time freshmen includes students who entered the University during Summer 2018 and Fall 2018. Approximately 62 percent of the class are females, and 37 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation comprise 25 percent of the group, while 19 percent are Christian (no affiliation) and 17 percent are Catholic.

Ninety-five percent of these students are United States citizens, while 157 first-time freshmen (4.6%) are resident or nonresident aliens representing 30 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' home addresses, the class of first-time freshmen is comprised of students from 47 states. Sixty-one percent of the first-time freshmen are from Texas.

Among students with high school class ranking, 40 percent were in the top ten percent of their high school graduating classes. The score range for the middle fifty percent of the entering first-year class is 1200 – 1350 with a mean score of 1277 for the Redesigned SAT and 26 – 31 with a mean score of 28.5 for the ACT.

Fall 2017

The class of 3,320 first-time freshmen includes students who entered the University during Summer 2017 and Fall 2017. Approximately 60 percent of the class are females, and 38 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation comprise 26 percent of the group, while 21 percent are Christian (no affiliation) and 18 percent are Catholic.

Ninety-seven percent of these students are United States citizens, while 114 first-time freshmen (3.4%) are resident or nonresident aliens representing 36 foreign countries. By domicile, as reflected in the students' home addresses, the class of first-time freshmen is comprised of students from 47 states and the District of Columbia. Sixty-three percent of the first-time freshmen are from Texas.

Among students with high school class ranking, 44 percent were in the top ten percent of their high school graduating classes. The score range for the middle fifty percent of the entering first-year class is 1200 – 1350 with a mean score of 1276 for the Redesigned SAT and 26 – 31 with a mean score of 28.2 for the ACT.
