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Profile of Baylor Interdisciplinary Core (BIC) Students Fall 2018

The Baylor Interdisciplinary Core (BIC) option for the general education degree requirements began in the fall of 1995. The BIC program offers a set of comprehensive interdisciplinary courses that provides an integrated approach to knowledge and learning. This profile contains descriptive information about students in the program for Fall 2018 with comparison information for all undergraduate students. Please note that BIC students are included in the undergraduate totals.

BIC enrollment for the Fall 2018 term consists of 683 students, which is 4.8% of the total undergraduate population. There are 201 first-time freshmen enrolled in the BIC program (6.0% of the overall entering class). The percentage of females in the BIC program is higher than the undergraduate female population (65.6% compared to 59.6%). Minority participation in the BIC program is lower than that for the undergraduate population (31.6% for BIC, 36.5% for all undergraduates).

Among the BIC students with a reported high school class ranking, 80.3% were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes. The score range for the middle fifty percent of the students in the BIC program is 1280-1420 with a mean score of 1350 for the Redesigned SAT and 28-32 with a mean score of 30.1 for the ACT examination. In comparison, the score range for the middle fifty percent of the undergraduate students is 1200-1350 with a mean score of 1278 for the Redesigned SAT and 26-31 with a mean score of 28.0 for the ACT examination.

The average credit hour load for BIC students is higher than the undergraduate population in all academic units. Overall, BIC students carry an average load of 15.7 hours while undergraduate students carry an average load of 15.1 hours. A higher percentage of BIC students are Pre-Law (26.1%) than the undergraduate students (7.1%), while the percentage of BIC students who are Pre-Med (16.1%) is comparable to the overall undergraduate population (16.0%).

* In this report, two race/ethnic group tables are presented. When providing information on their race and ethnicity, students were asked two questions. The first question asked the student: Are you Hispanic/Latino? The second question allowed students to select among five race categories, with multiple responses allowed. In the first table, students are counted in only one race/ethnic group category. If the student indicated “yes” to the first question, the student was categorized as Hispanic (only) regardless of any race code(s) they may have selected. If the student marked more than one race (and “no” to Hispanic/Latino in the first question), he/she was reported in the category of Multiracial. The second table counts a student in every race/ethnic group category he/she selected. The percentages in this table are based on the headcount of students.
