Profile of Baylor Interdisciplinary Core (BIC) Students, Fall 2009

The Baylor Interdisciplinary Core (BIC) option for the general education degree requirements began in the fall of 1995. The Baylor Bulletin describes the BIC program as an attempt to ". . . integrate various academic disciplines with a set of comprehensive interdisciplinary courses to provide a coherent approach to learning." This profile contains descriptive information about students in the program for Fall 2009 with comparison information for all undergraduate students. Please note that BIC students are included in the undergraduate totals.

There is a total BIC enrollment for the fall term of 559 students. Of these, 35 percent are male and 33 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Ninety-six percent of students in the BIC program are U.S. citizens (only 7 are international students and 14 have permanent residency in the United States). There are 182 first-time freshmen enrolled in the BIC program for the Fall 2009 semester.

Among the BIC students with a reported high school class ranking, 83 percent were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes. The score range for the middle fifty percent of the students in the BIC program is 1210 - 1360 with a mean score of 1281 for the SAT and 26 - 30 with a mean score of 28 for the ACT examination.
