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## Profile of Non-Returning Undergraduate Students Using National Student Clearinghouse Data Fall 2008 to Fall 2009

### Executive Summary

This report contains descriptive information about undergraduate students who were enrolled at Baylor University during Fall 2008 but did not return in Fall 2009.

- Of the 12,066 undergraduates enrolled in Fall 2008, 8,257 (68.4%) returned in Fall 2009, 1,190 (9.9%) did not return, and 2,619 (21.7%) graduated.
- Subsequent enrollment at another institution for the non-returning students was tracked using data from the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC). Of the 1,190 undergraduates who did not return, the NSC had Fall 2009 enrollment information on 742 (62.4%) of these students. The largest group of those students tracked by NSC enrolled at four-year public institutions.
- Of those students tracked by NSC, 80 (10.8%) enrolled at McLennan Community College in Fall 2009.
- In general, students who retained at Baylor had higher entrance test scores and high school quartiles than those students who did not return.

### Detailed Report

This report contains descriptive information about undergraduate students who were enrolled at Baylor University during Fall 2008 but did not return in Fall 2009. Included in this report is information about the following topics:

There were 12,066 undergraduate students enrolled in Fall 2008. Of these students, 8,257(68.4%) enrolled in Fall 2009 and 1,190 (9.9%) did not return. The remaining 2,619 (21.7%) graduated from the university. In order to seek additional information on the students who did not return, the Office of Institutional Research & Testing (IRT) submitted a file of these students to the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC). The NSC is a national repository of student records used for student degree and enrollment verification. The “Student Tracker” service from the NSC enables institutions to tap the nation’s largest enrollment database and track where students ultimately enroll.

IRT submitted the file of the 1,190 non-returning undergraduate students. The NSC had Fall 2009 enrollment information on 741 (62.2%) of these students. NSC provided information for each of these students including institution of matriculation, matriculation dates, institution type, and institution location. *One item to note is that the University of Texas – Austin does not participate in the NSC database.* Therefore, UT will not be listed as a transferring institution in this report.

The largest group of the non-returning students tracked using the NSC data enrolled in four-year public institutions. Table 1 breaks down enrollment by type of institution.

Appendix I contains detailed information for the Fall 2008 undergraduate students who returned to Baylor in Fall 2009 compared to those who did not return. The entire population of non-returning students (1,190) is examined as well as those students who were tracked by NSC according to institution type as defined in Table 1. Appendix II contains detailed information for students who enrolled at one of the top four transferring institutions as tracked by NSC.

Table 2 provides a summary of biographic and demographic information for Fall 2008 undergraduates who returned to Baylor in Fall 2009 compared to students who did not return to Baylor. See Appendix I for details. A smaller percentage of students who did not return were female (54.6%) compared to students who re-enrolled at Baylor (58.3%). A larger percentage of students who did not return were minorities (37.8%) compared to students who returned to Baylor (27.6%). A smaller percentage of students who did not return were Baptist (34.2%) as compared to those students who returned to Baylor (38.3%).

Table 3 provides a summary of academic information for Fall 2008 undergraduates who returned to Baylor in Fall 2009 compared to students who did not return to Baylor. See Appendix I for details. The average SAT score of students who returned to Baylor was higher (1212) than the average SAT score of students who did not return to Baylor (1157). A larger percentage of students who returned to Baylor were in the first quartile of their high school (71.5%) than those students who did not return to Baylor (57.1%).

Table 4 lists the top twenty transferring institutions tracked by the National Student Clearinghouse. These twenty institutions account for 54.7% of the students that enrolled at other institutions that are tracked by NSC. The list includes number of students who were enrolled at Baylor in Fall 2008 but enrolled at the transferring institution in Fall 2009, type of institution, and location of institution.

Table 5 provides a summary of biographic and demographic information for Fall 2008 undergraduates who returned to Baylor in Fall 2009 compared to non-returning students who enrolled at the top four transferring institutions. See Appendix II for details. A smaller percentage of students who returned to Baylor in Fall 2009 were minorities (27.6%) than the percentages of minorities that transferred to McLennan Community College, Lone Star College System District or University of North Texas. A smaller percentage of students who returned to Baylor in Fall 2009 were Baptist (38.3%) than students who transferred to McLennan Community College.

Table 6 provides a summary of academic information for Fall 2008 undergraduates who returned to Baylor in Fall 2009 compared to non-returning students who enrolled at the top four transferring institutions. See Appendix II for details. The average SAT score of students who returned to Baylor in Fall 2009 (1212) was higher than the average SAT score of students who enrolled at McLennan Community College, Lone Star College System District, University of North Texas, and Blinn College. A larger percentage of students who returned to Baylor in Fall 2009 (71.5%) were in the first quartile of their high school than those who enrolled at one of the top four transferring institutions.
