


Restore files from the Code42 app

Restore a single file

1. Sign in to backup.baylor.edu
2. See a list of backed-up files:
 - *Code42 app version 6.8.3 and later:*
 - i. Click **Restore Files**.
 - ii. *(Applies only if you have multiple devices)* From the menu, select the device that originally backed up the files you want to restore.
3. If you back up to multiple destinations, select the destination from **Restore files from**.
4. Navigate to the file you wish to restore.

5. Mouse over the file, and click the **download icon**  .
Your download is added to the [downloads manager](#) with the default [files options](#). The [downloads manager](#) displays the status of your download.

Restore multiple files

1. Sign in to the Code42 app.
2. See a list of backed-up files:
 - *Code42 app version 6.8.3 and later:*
 - i. Click **Restore Files**.
 - ii. *(Applies only if you have multiple devices)* From the menu, select the device that originally backed up the files you want to restore.
 - *Code42 app version 6.8.2 and earlier:*
 - i. Click **Get Files**.
3. If you back up to multiple destinations, select the destination from **Restore files from**.
4. Select the checkboxes for the folders and files you want to restore.
