**General Registration Information:** Required courseloads: **Spring 2023 Entering Students** will register for **Criminal Law, Contracts 2, Property 1, Torts 2 & LARC 2. Practice Court Students:** Practice Court 3 may be taken with electives, however, students in this class may not register for classes in the 1:20 p.m. and 2:40 p.m. timeslots with the exception of the Criminal Law Boot Camp and/or Capstone. PC students must have approval to take a class at 4:00 p.m. PC students interested in obtaining permission to do so must submit a request form (available on the registration page of the website) to the Registrar (considered in the order in which they are submitted). (1) Advanced Discovery Management is for PC and post PC students. (2) See Notes on Schedule for Information about the Extended Bar Preparation Skills Course, which is online and asynchronous. (3) The dates of the Criminal Law Bootcamp will be: Friday, June 23-25, 2023; students who are enrolled in an elective that normally meets on Friday at noon and after are responsible for visiting with the instructor of their regular Friday afternoon class about the potential absence on the Friday of the Boot Camp. The instructor will decide if the absence is excused or not. If the instructor of the regular Friday class opts to treat the absence as unexcused, the student must determine if he or she wishes to remain in the Boot Camp. Students who wish to drop a Boot Camp should do so no later than the first week of the quarter so that another student might have the opportunity to enroll in the Boot Camp. (4) The Criminal Law Capstone is for Practice Court Students. This capstone is comprised of various exercises and a lecture, the time of which will be scheduled not to conflict with the PC Lab or other classes the students are registered for. Information about the Criminal Law Bootcamp and Capstone is included in the Notes on Schedule. (5) Bus & State Issues in Environmental Law meets on Tuesdays at noon and 4:00 p.m., and Wednesdays at noon. (6) This class meets two consecutive 70 minute class periods one day per week. (7) Practice Court Lab will begin in the early afternoon most days. The lab consists of lectures and exercises. Students should plan to be available at 1:20 p.m. and after each day while they are taking PC. Exercises at times last into the evening. The PC faculty will provide a calendar to the class.
