Timeline and Checklist

- **Attend an event/visit campus.**
 - We host several events throughout the year. Refer to your Events handout or check the website for more details!
- **Pay your deposit.**
 - Refer to your decision letter for deadlines and processes.
- **Set up your BearID and your email, and log into BearWeb.**
 - You will receive information within two weeks of submitting your seat deposit.
- **File the FAFSA and send it to Baylor.**
 - You may file as early as October 1 for the next academic year, which begins in August. The preferred deadline is February 1, the final deadline is a month before classes begin. Please refer to your financial aid step-by-step for more information specific to differing entering classes.
- **Receive your financial aid package from Baylor University Financial Aid Office.**
 - You will receive your financial aid package after paying your seat deposit/after the Financial Aid Office has begun packing for your term. Refer to your financial aid step-by-step for more details.
- **Apply for and receive additional loans.**
 - You may apply beginning 90 days before you start classes. Try to apply no later than a month before you start classes.
- **Complete steps in registration email.**
 - Register for classes.
 - Send health forms.
 - Send matriculation forms.
 - You will receive an email with documents and instructions approximately 6 weeks before classes begin.
- **Receive your bill.**
 - Your bill will be emailed to you approximately 3 weeks before classes begin.

- **Make sure your bill is balanced.**
 - The balance on your bill will be due 10 days before classes begin.
- **Receive your book list and purchase books.**
 - You will be able to access your book list approximately 2 weeks before classes begin. You may purchase books online or at the Baylor Bookstore.
- **Receive refund.**
 - If you set up direct deposit through BearWeb, you will be able to receive excess financial aid 5 days before classes begin.
- **Attend Orientation.**
 - Mandatory Orientation is the Wednesday through Friday before classes begin.
- **Get a locker, student ID, and parking pass**
 - You will receive more information about lockers, student IDs, and parking passes as your entering quarter approaches.
