- STARTING OCTOBER 1<sup>st</sup> Go to <u>www.baylor.edu/missions/global</u> OR the link listed for the specific team (we've got search features set up for you to find the best fit for you)

- Fill out application & check off materials prior to deadline below.

- Some teams will also interview students so get apps in early!
