As we continue to encounter rapidly changing and uncertain circumstances regarding health and safety protocols arising from the COVID-19 pandemic, Baylor University has canceled all Study Abroad programs for Summer Session II 2021. Similarly, Baylor will continue to restrict University-sponsored international travel for students, staff and faculty through Aug. 22, 2021. We are planning for normal Fall semester Study Abroad programs and anticipate that University-sponsored international travel also will resume at the beginning of the Fall semester as circumstances allow.

These restrictions will be reviewed monthly and revised as appropriate if circumstances change. The [Center for Global Engagement](#) will continue to work with the Director of Global Safety and Security to monitor travel risks in accordance with Baylor University policy and will evaluate requests for exceptions to the current travel restrictions.
