ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Competency in providing cognitive and behavioral interventions to individuals, families, couples and groups with identified behavioral health/substance abuse problems in a primary care setting. Practice the integrated behavioral health care model and assist in providing training and education in that area. Consult with patients, providing a functional and strength-based assessment and diagnosis, problem solving cognitive intervention, substance use/abuse evaluation and medication adherence counseling. Consult with PCP, providing feedback to enhance the understanding of the patient and provide decision support in co-managing a patient's health issues that may speak to both medical and major psychiatric disorders that warrant brief psychotherapy services. Assist health care team in development of treatment plans and provide consultation to and coordinate patient care with primary care staff, being an advocate for patients needing specialty behavioral health or other services. Be immediately available to the clinic staff during work hours in the event of a psychiatric emergency and other possible health behavior emergencies. Develop and maintain thorough knowledge of referral resources throughout the service area. Acts as a resource for other members of the health care team, providing in-service education and consultation in understanding the social and emotional factors related to health problems. Understand and comply to HIPAA reporting obligations with written consent from the patient that the LCSW is employed as a part of a primary care team approach to addressing the patient's health issues. Complete and maintain all charting accurately and timely, including clinical assessment, progress notes and billing, according to department policy. Participates in planning and implementing quality behavioral improvement initiatives. Maintains up-to-date knowledge of field by participating in continuing education activities.</p>
