Job Description (including hours and responsibilities)	The Harris Center for Mental Health and IDD ("The HARRIS CENTER") is looking for a Care Coordinator - MCOT Rapid Response to join our team. Under the general direction of the Program Director, Clinical Team Lead, or designated staff the Care Coordinator performs clinical activities such as independent assessments and service interventions as directed by identified consumer need(s). This position interfaces with Treatment Teams both inpatient and outpatient and authorizes the medical necessity of services, as indicated. This position is responsible for providing the following services: crisis intervention, safety planning, mental health assessments, post hospitalization follow-up, and liaison between the agency and the community. MCOT Rapid Response interfaces with other programs in the Agency, law enforcement, and the community. What you will do: •The MCOT Rapid Response CC is assigned to a MCOT Rapid Response crisis team. The crisis team is composed of a LPHA and CC providing community-based crisis assessments to determine needed level of care. •The MCOT Rapid Response CC provides crisis intervention to individuals to reduce symptoms, provide education and prevent admission to a more restrictive environment. •The MCOT Rapid Response CC will transport consumers to a psychiatric or medical hospital if a higher level of care is required. •The MCOT Rapid Response CC provides post hospitalization follow-up to provide consumers support in coordinating access to necessary mental health care and services. •The MCOT Rapid Response CC educates family members so they may understand the individual's mental health

	symptoms, treatment and assist with referring to community resources. •The MCOT Rapid Response CC provides information on mental health, the importance of medications and treatment compliance, and other clinical related information to individual, family, community as needed. •The MCOT Rapid Response CC completes electronic documentation each work day as outlined in MCOT Operating Guidelines. This documentation becomes part of the medical record for the Agency. •The MCOT Rapid Response CC, when interacting with the community and colleagues, follows the key principles of a trauma informed approach (i.e. safety, trustworthiness and transparency, peer support, collaboration and mutuality, empowerment, voice and choice, cultural, historical, and gender issues). •The MCOT Rapid Response CC performs related work as assigned and adapts to changing work requirements. •The MCOT Rapid Response CC demonstrates ethical conduct in all professional activities. •The MCOT Rapid Response CC complies with Agency policies and procedures and MCOT Operating Guidelines. •The MCOT Rapid Response CC is available to provide any assistance not listed above to the Agency, Program Director, Clinical Team Lead, or staff as requested and required.
